This document outlines the **required documentation** and **eligibility criteria** for each membership level, ensuring a transparent and rigorous selection process.

Artisan Membership

Color: Silver Description:

Artisan Membership is reserved for skilled calligraphers who consistently produce high-quality work and actively engage in UAC projects and exhibitions. This level recognizes technical proficiency and commitment to the calligraphy community.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Demonstrated Technical Proficiency:
 - A portfolio featuring 15–20 high-quality calligraphy works.
 - Inclusion of multiple styles showcasing versatility and mastery.
- 2. Active Involvement in UAC Events:
 - Participation in at least two UAC exhibitions, projects, or events.
 - Submission of certificates or official documentation as evidence.
- 3. Comprehensive Resume or CV:
 - Detailing relevant calligraphy achievements, experience, and education.
- 4. Professional Recommendation Letter:
 - A recommendation from a recognized calligraphy master or a UAC official.
 - Must attest to the applicant's skills and contributions to the field.
- 5. Written Statement:
 - A detailed statement comprising **500–700 words**.
 - Discussing the impact of calligraphy on personal or cultural development.



Required Documentation:

Advanced Portfolio:

• A collection of calligraphy works demonstrating technical skill and artistic expression.

Event Participation Proof:

• Certificates, media coverage, or official summaries of involvement in UAC events.

Resume or CV:

 Outlining professional experience, achievements, and contributions to Arabic calligraphy.

Recommendation Letter:

• A formal letter from a distinguished calligraphy master or UAC representative.

Statement of Impact:

 An extensive narrative discussing personal growth and cultural significance through calligraphy.

Additional Requirements:

Application Submission:

 Applications must be submitted through the UAC Membership Portal or directly at the UAC Membership Office.

Verification:

 All documentation will be thoroughly reviewed to confirm eligibility and adherence to criteria.
